### MEDICAL PERMISSION FORM

All medications must be brought to the school office by a parent or legal guardian. The teachers cannot accept medication. The students may not carry any medication (including over the counter) on their person during the school day.

Medication can be dispensed provided the following guidelines are followed;

1. A Medical Permission Form must be completed by a parent or guardian.
2. The medication is in its ORIGINAL container. Prescription medication can be dispensed in two containers if mentioned to the Pharmacist when the script is dropped off.
3. Written instructions stating the TIME AND DOSAGE for administration of medication is provided.
